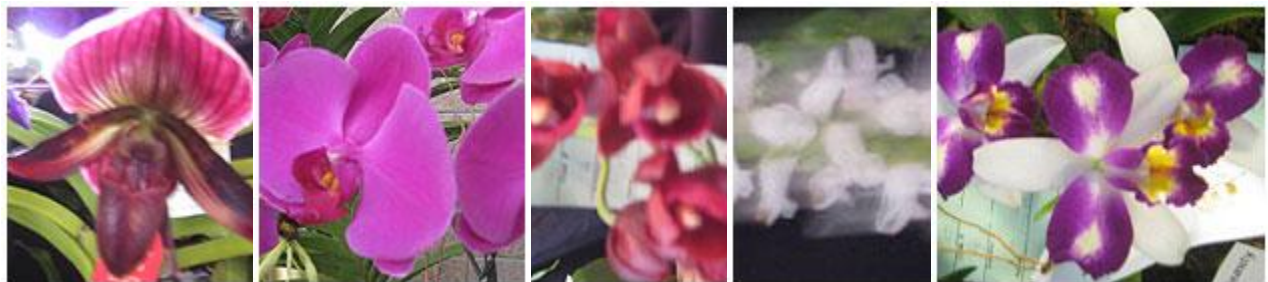

Michiana Orchid Society Holds Show at HCC for the 10th Year



The Michiana Orchid Society held their annual Orchid Show in the atrium of Holy Cross College for the 10th year the weekend of October 31-November 1. An estimated 1,000 people viewed many varieties of orchids during the two-day show. Sandra Ohlund, a Spanish instructor at Holy Cross College, was the chairperson of the show. Sandra is a past president and a co-founder of the Michiana Orchid society.

The Orchid society is made up of some 35 persons. The society was founded in 1981 and held their show at the Cook Nuclear Plant prior to the year 2000. Four national awards were given at the show by the National Orchid Society. Some 15 trophies and ribbons for 1st through 3rd place were also awarded for entries in a possible 103 categories. The society has been very pleased with the use of the Holy Cross College facility for their annual show.
